Accelerated Training in Defense Manufacturing (ATDM)

If you stopped by their booth at Action Days, you might remember that the Accelerated Training in Defense Manufacturing (ATDM) program is designed to help adult learners earn the skills necessary to make an immediate impact in the Defense Industrial Base (DIB).

ATDM is funded by the U.S. Navy and was created to teach the skills needed to increase military equipment production. All program areas are 16 weeks with 600+ hours of instruction. Each individual program area is designed to equip individuals with the foundational skills needed to make an immediate impact in the DIB workforce. Skilled trades include:

- Additive Manufacturing
- CNC Machining
- Non-destructive Testing
- Quality Control Inspection (also known as Metrology)
- Welding

Cybersecurity Readiness

The U.S. Department of Defense announced a <u>new cybersecurity strategy for 2024-2027</u>. It aims to sustain a resilient Joint Force and defense ecosystem by protecting it from cyber threats. This strategy focuses on coordinating efforts across the Department to identify and close gaps in cybersecurity, ensuring the protection of networks, supply chains, and critical resources. Emphasizing a digital-first, data-driven culture, the strategy also highlights the importance of modernizing business practices, investing in technology, and retaining a skilled cyber workforce to safeguard national security.

In a recent piece in <u>C4ISRNET</u>, Shannon Vaughn, General Manager at Virtru Federal, a provider of data security services for the government, breaks down the four biggest takeaways.



Small Business Administration (SBA)
